### **Stars Lineup for the Greeley Stampede**

Shine up your cowboy boots, find your leather jacket and spike your hair. The Greeley Stampede has announced their 2012 concert series lineup.

With the Stampede Super Stars Pass, music lovers will be able to see all 5 shows for only \$80 for reserved seating or \$50 for general admission tickets - less than the cost of two individual performances.

The star studded eclectic group includes country artists Justin Moore, Luke Bryan, and Montgomery Gentry; the hard-driving alternative rock band, Skillet and a fifth artist, expected to be a classic rock band, yet to be announced.

Tickets for the 2012 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary season are available beginning Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup> at 9am, just in time for the holidays.

Country crooner Justin Moore, performing June 22<sup>nd</sup>, embodies the soul and character of a kid from a small town, specifically Poyen, Arkansas. He has charted six times on the Hot Country Songs charts, including the number one hits "Small Town USA" and "If Heaven Wasn't So Far Away," featured on his second album, "Outlaws Like Me."

New country superstar Luke Bryan performs June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Bryan released his third album, "Tailgates and Tanlines," August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The Album released at #1 on the Country Charts and #2 on the Pop Charts. He performed his latest single "Country Girl (Shake It For Me)" at the CMT Music Awards June 8<sup>th</sup> 2011, as a featured solo performance at the awards.

Montgomery Gentry, performing July 3<sup>rd</sup>, has been a nationally popular duo since 1999. In 2009 they were inducted into the Grand Ole Opry and on October 18<sup>th</sup> 2011 released their tenth album. Still strong, the album's latest hits include "Hell Yeah" and "My Town."

Skillet, performing July 1<sup>st</sup>, won the 2011 Top Christian Album at the Billboard Music Awards with their album, "Comatose" after its number four debut on the Billboard Top Christian Albums. The band is currently headlining the tour "Awake and Alive" and in 2012, they will headline the 2012 Winter Jam Tour Spectacular. Their song "Awake and Alive" hit number 13 on the Billboard Rock Music charts last spring.

Another classic rock artist, to be determined soon, will perform June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

The 2012 Greeley Stampede, starting June 22<sup>nd</sup> and running through July 4<sup>th</sup>, will be celebrating 90 Years and Hundreds of Thrills. The largest event in Northern Colorado will also feature again this year the popular Carnival Americana, Kids Korral, multiple free concert stages, Western Invitational Art Show and Fireworks display.

Tickets for PRCA Rodeo and Xtreme Bull Riding, Colorado's Largest Demolition Derby, and Jesse James, A Saloon Musical, are available beginning 9 AM Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup> in addition to the concert lineup.
